

## **Rose Hill Read/Swap Library**

On a number of occasions the residents of Rose Hill have identified the need for a permanent library facility on the estate. With the redevelopment of part of the estate a sum of developer money is to be allocated for improving the facilities on Rose Hill. The County Council has agreed £5,000 can be put towards library provision. A committee of enthusiastic local volunteers meet regularly and with the support of all the major stakeholders on the estate are working towards an exciting new adventure for all residents to be a part of. The Norman Brown Room in the Community Centre has kindly been made available by the Community Association. Volunteers will run the library one morning a week and one afternoon a week. It is planned to open in late summer 2009. The aim is to provide a friendly social environment where people can feel relaxed and meet.
